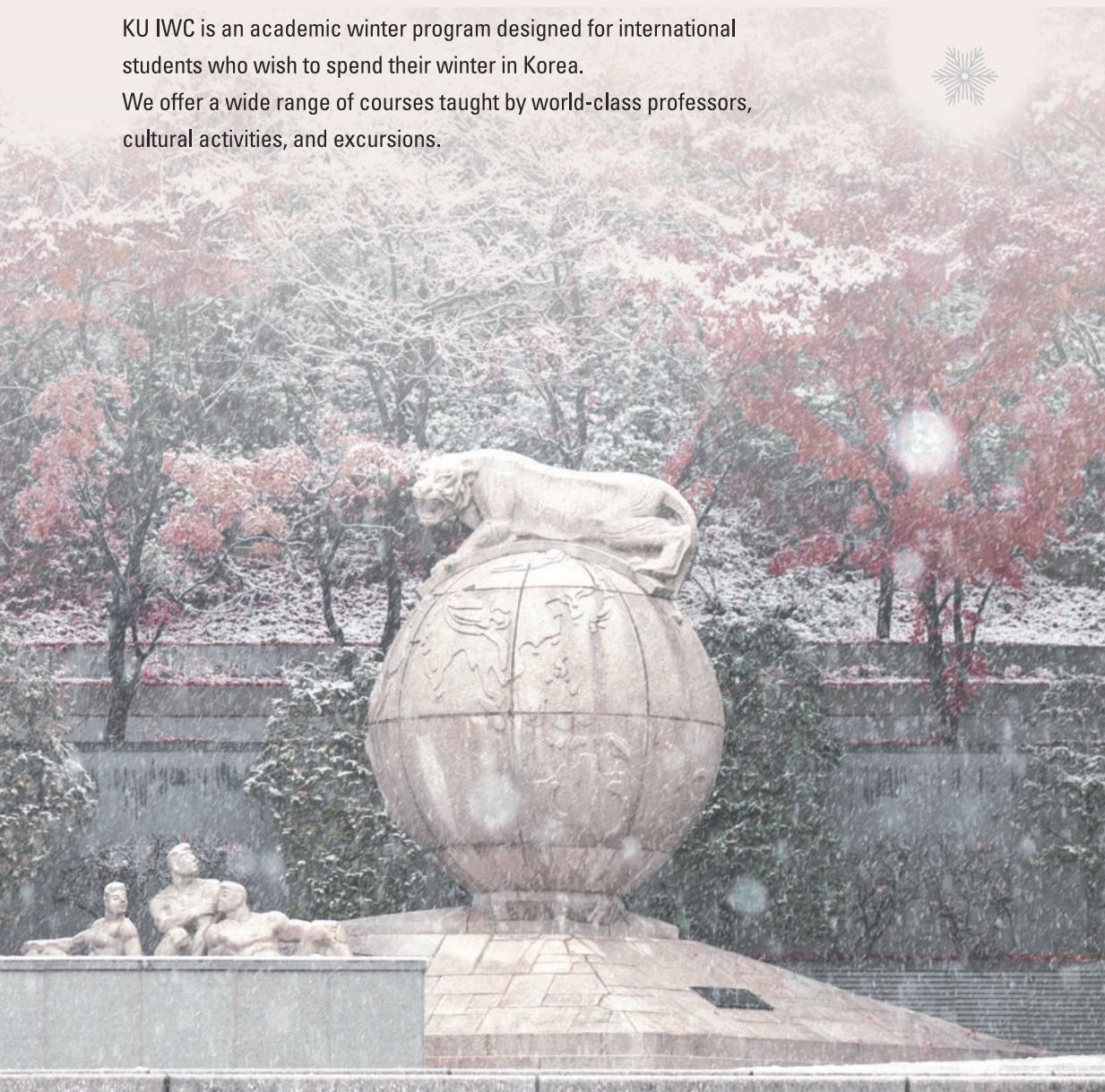




Korea University International Winter Campus

 - *Only for students enrolled in in-person courses
- Consent Letter signed by a legal guardian
 - *Only for pre-college students

Eligibility

- Students currently enrolled in an accredited college/university
- Academically motivated high school students or high school graduates (Year 11, 12)

Application Procedures

- Complete the online application form at winter.korea.ac.kr
 - *Course selection to be completed through the online application form
- Pay the application fee of KRW 100,000
 - *Non-refundable
- Send the required documents to kuwinter@korea.ac.kr
- Receive the 'Letter of Acceptance' via email
- Pay the tuition and all remaining fees
